

Network of RCC Turnaround Liaisons

What is the network of Regional Comprehensive Center (RCC) turnaround liaisons?

The network of RCC turnaround liaisons consists of leaders in each of the 15 comprehensive center regions whose work with states involves school turnaround and improvement.

What are the network's goals?

The goals of the network are to:

- To improve communication among the RCCs
- To improve communication between the Center on School Turnaround (CST) and the RCCs
- Leverage and promote RCC turnaround work
- Identify any areas of collaboration

What is the role of RCC turnaround liaisons?

RCC turnaround liaisons will help serve as the eyes and ears of the Center on School Turnaround (CST) to ensure that relevant information can be broadly shared. Through email and quarterly conference calls, liaisons will share turnaround-related news articles, resources, and policy updates from the states in their regions. The shared articles, resources, and policy changes will be vetted by CST staff and ultimately disseminated via the CST's social media outlets and website.

Who belongs to the network?

One or more representatives from each RCC, whose work involves school turnaround and improvement, will serve as members of the network.

How often will the network communicate?

The network of RCC turnaround liaisons will convene quarterly via conference calls and be contacted monthly by email. Additional interaction will occur as needed.
